Join the Patient Resource Team:

Serve on the Medical Team

Use your abilities to provide care and information to our clients, including pregnancy testing, obtaining health histories, and educating them about sexual and reproductive health care. This requires a one-half-day-a-week commitment.

Care Coordinator

Our relationship with our client usually begins when she comes in for a pregnancy test. She meets with a Care Coordinator who listens to her situation, encourages her by speaking the truth in love, and guides the client in critical thinking skills to equip her to make a good decision. This position requires the completion of an extensive training program, which requires a one-half-day-a-week commitment.

Parent Education Team

The purpose of our parenting resources is to guide mothers and fathers through the journey of pregnancy and parenthood. Families attend classes and Bible studies and receive items from our Baby Boutique.
