Join the Patient Resource Team*:

Serve on the Medical Team

Do you have a medical background or education? Possibility to volunteer as a medical assistants and use your abilities to give care and information to our clients. This may include things such as pregnancy testing, obtaining health histories, giving referrals for prenatal care, and education about sexual & reproductive health care.

Become a Care Coordinator (Lay Counselor)*

Our relationship with our client usually begins when she comes in for a pregnancy test. She meets with a Care Coordinator who listens to her situation, encourages her by speaking the truth in love, and guides the client in critical thinking skills to equip her to make a good decision. This position requires completion of an extensive training program.

Become a Receptionist*/ Follow-up Volunteer *

The first person our clients see in our office is the <u>Receptionist</u>. Receptionists sit at our front desk in order to greet and direct clients and do light clerical work. They are trained to answer the phone and will use the computer to schedule appointments for pregnancy tests. Receptionists have opportunities to visit with friends or family who may be accompanying a client. <u>Follow-up volunteers</u> are responsible for making reminder and follow-up phone calls.

Become a Post Abortion Support/Facilitator**
